"I write these things to you, hoping to come to you soon. But if I should be delayed, I have written so that you will know how people ought to conduct themselves in God's household, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and foundation of the truth." (1 Timothy 3:14-15)

The Apostle Paul used some serious language to talk about the church when he wrote to his protégé, Timothy. When we think of church, we do not think of "the pillar and foundation of the truth." We think of a place we choose to go to worship God. But Paul thinks of it differently. He thinks of it as "God's household." God, of course, is the head of the house and dictates how things go for His family. But note that it is God's household, not the household of some pastor or prominent family. And it is "the pillar and foundation of the truth." Both of those words are words for structural support. Not only does the church connect people to the family of God, it also provides structural support for the truth.

And our world desperately needs truth. So much confusion, so much anger. So much unrighteousness. So much lawlessness. Our Lord Jesus created and established the church for just such a place. What better gift to a lost and confused world than the gift of the church? I will continue the series on the church, titled "Church Matters," during the month of August. If we learn well how to conduct ourselves in God's household, we will be more effective at providing the right platform for the truth. Join us this month.


