⇒**TRAIL LIFE:** will meet January 12th, 19th, and 26th.

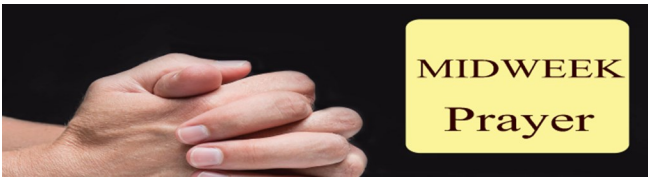
⇒**YOUNG AT HEART:** Monday, January 13th at Noon. Bring a covered dish and enjoy the fellowship. We will play bingo.
