⇒**BAPTISM SUNDAY:** Join us Sunday, July 24th during the 11 am service for our family and friends being baptized.

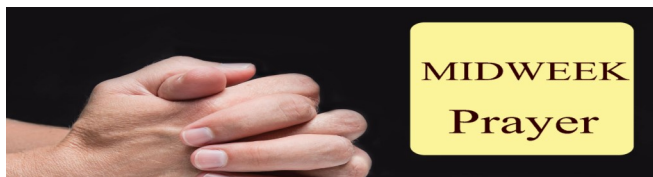
