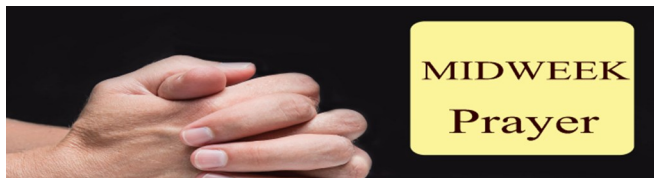
⇒**MOVIE NIGHT:** This Saturday, September 20th at the Youth House. The students will watch the movie *"The Blind."*
